



## Beautiful Feet

Vast numbers of people still live without the knowledge and good news of Jesus Christ. Swaziland has historically been called a "Christian Nation," however we have found that the majority of children here have never been taught the truths of Jesus and what he's done for them. It's really very sad how poor a job we, the church have done in reaching and discipling the next generation.

Recently, one of our MKs (missionary kids), Hudson Freeman wrote a song about beautiful feet from Romans 10. As I listened to him perform it one Sunday morning at church, I was reminded of my responsibility to pass on the good news. People still live without the knowledge of Christ only because there aren't enough beautiful feet. The passage in Romans states, "Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved," and goes on to ask the rhetorical questions of how can they

believe if they haven't heard and how can they hear without someone to preach. If the lost are to hear, we must preach the good news ourselves and disciple others to do the same!

It is with this conviction that we have recently focussed much attention on training teachers. In September, we had Phil Malcolm, missionary and children's ministry expert with us in Swaziland for our very first multi-day training conference. We were thrilled to have nearly 40 teachers in attendance, and believe that many more children will receive the good news because of it.
